### Psychoses

- A. Organic psychotic conditions
  - Dementias
  - Alcohol induced mental disorder
  - Drug induced mental disorder
  - Transient mental disorders due to conditions classified elsewhere
  - Persistent mental disorder due to conditions classified elsewhere
- B. Other Psychoses
  - Schizophrenic disorders (simple type, disorganized type, catatonic type, paranoid type, schizophreniform disorder, latent schizophrenia, residual type, schizoaffective disorder, other specified types of schizophrenia, unspecified schizophrenia)
  - Episodic mood disorders (bipolar disorders, manic disorders, major depressive disorders, melancholia, mood disorders, mood swings)
  - Delusional disorder (paranoid states, paraphrenia, shared psychotic disorder)
  - Other nonorganic psychoses (depressive type psychosis, excitative type psychosis, reactive confusion, acute paranoid reaction, other and unspecified reactive psychosis, unspecified psychosis)
  - Pervasive developmental disorders (autistic disorder, childhood disintegrative disorder, other specified pervasive developmental disorder, unspecified pervasive developmental disorder)

### **Other NonPsychotic Mental Disorders**

- A. Sexual and gender identity disorders
- B. Alcohol dependence syndrome
- C. Drug dependence
- D. Physiological malfunction arising from mental factors (psychogenic physical symptoms not involving tissue damage)
- E. Special symptoms or syndromes not elsewhere classified (This category is intended for use if the psychopathology is manifested by a single specific symptom or group of symptoms which is not part of an organic illness or other mental disorder classified elsewhere.)
  - Stuttering
  - Anorexia nervosa
  - Stereotypic movement disorder
  - Specific disorders of sleep of nonorganic origin
  - Other and unspecified disorders of eating
  - Enuresis (primary) (secondary) of nonorganic origin
  - Encopresis (continuous) (discontinuous) of nonorganic origin
  - Pain disorders related to psychological factors
- F. Acute reaction to stress
- G. Adjustment reaction
- H. Disturbance of conduct, not elsewhere classified
- I. Disturbance of emotions specific to childhood and adolescence
- J. Hyperkinetic syndrome of childhood
